

I, the undersigned, being first duly sworn and under oath, state that the following facts known by me or told to me by other reliable person form the basis for my belief that John David Gogola, the Defendant committed the crime charged:

Through an investigation by the Iowa State Auditor's Office and the Iowa Division of Criminal Investigation, it was discovered that John Gogola diverted funds from UNItix, the University of Northern Iowa's centralized ticketing office, to his own personal debit and credit cards. This activity took place during the time frame of December 29, 2008 through August 31, 2010. During this time frame, Gogola was employed as an assistant director with UNItix and had access to the UNItix system. The State Auditor's Office identified \$16,412.00 in UNItix funds which were diverted to Gogola's personal debit and credit cards.
