

Reciprocal Licensing Agreements with Other States

The State of Iowa Electrical Examining Board has reciprocal licensing agreements with Arkansas, Colorado, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. The applicant must have passed an approved State-sponsored examination with a score of 75% or greater, held the qualifying license for 1 year which cannot have been expired, suspended, or revoked; cannot have taken the Iowa exam and failed it; and **must meet additional Iowa licensure requirements** in order for the license to qualify for reciprocity.

Reciprocal **Journeyman** Licenses:

- Arkansas Journeyman license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to an Arkansas Journeyman license.
- Colorado Journeyman license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to a Colorado Journeyman license.
- Minnesota Class A Journeyman license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to a Minnesota Class A Journeyman license.
- Montana Journeyman license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to a Montana Journeyman license.
- Nebraska Journeyman license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to a Nebraska Journeyman license.
- North Dakota Journeyman license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to a North Dakota Journeyman license.
- Oklahoma Journeyman license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to an Oklahoma Journeyman license.
- South Dakota Journeyman license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to a South Dakota Journeyman license.
- Wisconsin Journeyman Electrician license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Journeyman Class A license may reciprocate to a Wisconsin Journeyman Electrician license.

Reciprocal **Master or Electrical Contractor** Licenses:

- Arkansas Master license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to an Arkansas Journeyman license.
- Colorado Master license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to a Colorado Journeyman license.
- Minnesota Class A Master license may reciprocate to an Iowa Master or Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to a Minnesota Class A Master or Journeyman license.
- Montana Master license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to a Montana Journeyman license.
- Nebraska Electrical Contractor license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to a Nebraska Journeyman license.
- North Dakota Master license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to a North Dakota Journeyman license.
- Oklahoma Electrical Contractor license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to an Oklahoma Journeyman license.
- South Dakota Electrical Contractor license may reciprocate to an Iowa Journeyman or Master Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to a South Dakota Journeyman or Electrical Contractor license.

- Wisconsin Master Electrician license may reciprocate to an Iowa Master or Journeyman Class A license, or an Iowa Master Class A license may reciprocate to a Wisconsin Journeyman or Master Electrician license.
