## Notice to State of Iowa Licensed Electricians

To: -Licensed Master A, Master B, Journeyman A, and Journeyman B Electricians  
From: Iowa Electrical Examining Board  
Date: July 21, 2010  
Re: Continuing Education Units (CEU's) & License Expiring

---

Your State of Iowa Electrician License will expire on December 31, 2010. Each 3-year license will require 18 hours of Continuing Education Units (CEU's), of which at least 6 hours must be over the National Electrical Code. The remainder may be on electrical-related material that is approved by the Board. If desired, you may have all 18 hours of CEU's over the NEC. If your electrician license was pro-rated, you will need 6 hours of CEU's per year from when your license approval letter was received.

Please visit the link below to find verification of your CEU's, as well as a listing of electrical courses that are available if your hours are not complete. **If the required CEU's are not completed by December 31, 2010, you will not be able to renew your electrician license, and you must (re)take and pass the State-sponsored electrician examination. Late fees will be assessed as well.**

If there is a discrepancy on the verification of your hours, please contact the class instructor(s) first to verify that the credit hours and your electrician license number were submitted correctly.
