Poster Contest

Rules:

- 1) Applicant must be in the **5th grade**.
- 2) Poster should demonstrate the theme **“Bring Our Missing Children Home”**. **This phrase MUST appear somewhere on the poster.**
- 3) The theme must be depicted visually in one or a combination of mediums, such as: **crayons, pastels, magic markers, pencil, watercolor, acrylics**, etc. Digitally produced images, collages, cut-outs and stamping **will not** be eligible for consideration.
- 4) **The finished poster MUST measure 8 1/2 x 14 inches.** (Legal size paper)



- 5) Must be submitted with a **completed application**, which includes a description of the poster and a brief biography of the artist (neither to exceed 100 words) either legibly written or typed.
- 6) Must be received by **February 28, 2012**, and sent or delivered to:

- 7) The poster chosen as the winner in Iowa will be submitted to the national competition. The national winner, his/her teacher and his/her parents will win a trip to Washington, DC.
